

Hillsdale County Medical Care Facility Outdoor Visit and Covid-19 Information

Per guidance from the Department of Health and Human Service

COVID-19 GENERAL INFORMATION:

PLEASE DO NOT ATTEMPT TO VISIT IF YOU HAVE ANY OF THESE SIGNS OR SYMPTOMS

1. New onset of a fever (100.0 degrees F) or cough.
2. Shortness of breath or sore throat.
3. Body aches or headache not associated with any other chronic condition.
4. A new onset of diarrhea, vomiting or loss of taste or smell.

PRECAUTIONS TO PREVENT GETTING COVID-19

1. Wear a mask when in any public space.
2. Maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet.
3. Wash your hands with soap and water or hand sanitizer often.
4. Avoid traveling or attending crowded places or hot spots.

PLEASE CONTACT US IMMEDIATELY IF YOU HAVE

1. Any signs or symptoms listed or if you develop symptoms within 14 days of your visit.
2. Have traveled to another state for an extended visit or have been out of the United States.
3. If you have had any known exposure to someone with COVID-19.

HCMCF OUTDOOR VISITING POLICY

1. All visits will be by appointment only and will be scheduled for 15 minutes each.
2. Only 2 visitors (aged 16 years and over) per resident per visit.
3. Visitors will enter and exit at the marked, designated area only. At the check area health screening, education, instructions for handwashing and proper use of personal protective equipment (PPE) and sign in will occur before entry.
The entry will be located at the patio gate in the circle drive.
4. ALL VISITORS WILL BE SCREENED FOR ILLNESS, FEVER AND POSSIBLE EXPOSURE BEFORE EACH VISIT.
5. You are encouraged to bring your own mask and they will be available at the check in desk if you do not have one. Hand sanitizer will be available at check in and other locations.
6. The visiting area must always be monitored for social distancing and proper use of masks.
Visitors who are unwilling or unable to wear a face covering (or PPE as appropriate) for the duration of the visit, and persons unable to follow hand hygiene requirements will be encouraged to use video or other forms of remote communication.
7. All tables and other equipment will be sanitized between each visit.
8. Please do not bring items to leave with your resident. Do not share food with residents.
9. Visitors are asked not to arrive more than 5 minutes before their schedule time and maintain social distancing before entering.

Visits will be scheduled Monday through Friday 10:00am – 3:00pm.

Please call to make an appointment. As needed, we encourage you to leave a message detailing the resident's name, your name, relationship, and phone number. We will return your call as soon as possible. Messages left after hours will be returned the next morning and weekend messages on Mondays.

We will make every attempt to make up visits cancelled due to weather.
